Why no Trays?

In order to reduce our carbon footprint, we are taking a closer look at our environmental impact.

Food Waste

When students use plates without trays the amount of food waste decreases by one ounce per plate.

Water Usage

Research also shows less energy is consumed, and it reduces the amount of water and detergents used. It takes $\frac{1}{4}$ gallon of water to wash a tray. For 20 meals in a week, that's 4 gallons, or skipping one shower a month.
